Ling-Tai Lynette Chou, Professor of Accounting at National Chengchi University (NCCU), previously served as the University Dean of Student Affairs, Associate Dean of Teaching & Learning and Director of Participation Education & Research Development Office of the College of Commerce, and Chairman of the Department of Accounting. Being the former President of Taiwan Accounting Association and Vice President at-Large of International Association for Accounting Education and Research, she takes part in academic conferences and organizations regularly.

Professor Chou's research interests include audit quality, internal control/related parties & transactions disclosures, financial reporting/management control for universities and the public sector. She has published in academic journals such as Abacus, Journal of Accounting Review, NTU Management Review, Sun Yat-Sen Management Review, Accounting Research, Educational Policy Forum, Taiwan Accounting Review, Review of Business, Management Review, Review of Securities and Futures Markets, Industry and Management Forum, etc. Her teaching cases can be found in Ivey School Publishing and other case centers.

Professor Chou is currently the Supervisor of the Higher Education Evaluation & Accreditation Council of Taiwan, and the Institute for Information Industry. She also serves on the Taiwan Financial Supervisory Commission's Appeals Board of Certified Public Accountant Disciplinary Sanction, NCC Cable Radio and TV Fund Management Committee and the Government Accounting Standards Committee of DGBAS (Directorate General of Budget, Accounting and Statistics). Professor Chou was the Supervisor of Taiwan's Public Television Service, First Financial Holding Co. and First Bank.
